The independent Local Government Boundary Commission for England is carrying out an electoral review of Gloucestershire County Council.

The aim of the review is to deliver a new pattern of county divisions where each division is represented by one county councillor. Our review will also ensure that everyone's vote in county elections is of roughly equal value wherever you live in the county.

In the first stage of our review, we proposed that the County Council should have 53 councillors.

Now we're asking for evidence about your local area to help us decide a new pattern of divisions for the whole county.
